Upcoming work 19 June 2023

Weekend closure of A11 northbound Browick/Mulbarton carriageway

As per our recent e-bulletin dated 5 June 2023, we need to close a small section of the A11 northbound between the Browick Road junction exit and entry slip roads from **8pm 23 June 2023 until 6am on Monday 26 June 2023.** This is so we can carry out drainage work.

A clearly signed 'up and over' diversion route will be in place, which will divert traffic off the A11 at the Browick Road northbound exit slip road, before re-joining the A11 at the Browick Road northbound entry slip road.

A11 northbound overnight carriageway closure

As part of the above work, we'll also need an overnight closure of the A11 northbound carriageway between Attleborough to Thickthorn, on 23 June 2023, from 8pm until 6am. At 6am the A11 northbound carriageway will reopen, aside from the small section between the Browick Road junction exit and entry slip roads, which will reopen at 6am on Monday 26 June 202 (as per the weekend closure information above).

A clearly signed diversion route will be in place throughout this overnight closure. Traffic wishing to travel northbound on the A11 will be diverted along the A1066 at Thetford, before travelling eastbound on the A140, and then northbound towards the A47. At the A47 junction join the A47 westbound to Thickthorn interchange. You can find a map of the diversion route at the end of this eBulletin.

We're sorry for the disruption this work may cause to your journey and encourage drivers to plan ahead and allow extra time when travelling. Please note that these closures are subject to change at short notice due to unforeseen circumstances or poor weather conditions.
