B1077 Queens Road, Attleborough - Road Resurfacing

Work is due to commence from Sunday 3 September 2023 to carry out essential road resurfacing works on the B1077 Queens Road between B1077 Exchange Street and the A11 Slip Road Junction. A 25m section into the U33205 Cyprus Road junction will also be resurfaced. The work will see the old worn out road surface removed and replaced with a new asphalt surface.

The work is expected to take 6 days, running to 7pm on Friday 8 September. During this time the road will be closed for works from 5pm – 7am on the night of Sunday 3 to Monday 4 September to complete the works from the Exchange Street end to past the Lidl access junction, weather permitting.

The remaining works up to the A11 Slip Road junction will be completed over the following 5 days Monday 04 September – Friday 08 September, requiring daytime closure of Queens Road (7am-7pm), weather permitting. During the works the road closures for through traffic will be required for the durations of works.

We will reduce the impact on road users as much as possible, and we will ensure that the noisiest surfacing works are completed before 11pm to help minimise disturbance.

During the works access will be maintained to businesses and properties within the limits of the closure (Including Queens Court, Queens Close and Royal Court) with site staff able to allow access from one side of the works at all times. A signed diversion route will be in place during the works for both the Queens Road and Cyprus Road closures. The road closures are essential to ensure the works are conducted in a safe and efficient manner.

Pedestrian access will be maintained throughout the works.

We are grateful for people's patience while this essential road surface improvement work takes place. If access for emergency services is required the site staff will ensure access past the works.

The County Council thanks people for their patience while this Carriageway improvement work is carried out.

The work which will cost £152,900 will be carried out by Norfolk County Council's Community and Environmental Services Department and their contractors.
