Temporary Restriction of Traffic Movement

Norfolk County Council has made a Temporary Traffic Regulation Order affecting the:

- 1) **B1077 Connaught Road** from its junction B1077 Surrogate Street to its junction with the C572 High Street;
- 2) **Edenside Drive** from its junction with the B1077 Connaught Road for 90m southwards;
- 3) **B1077 Exchange Street** from its junction with High Street to its junction with Church Street; and
- 4) **B1077 Church Street** from its junction with Queens Road to its junction with the B1077 Norwich Road

in the TOWN OF ATTLEBOROUGH to facilitate the staging of the Attleborough Remembrance Event 2023.

The roads (1) to (4) will be temporarily prohibited (except for emergency and pedestrian access) between 10:00 and 12:00 on 12th November 2023 for the duration of the event expected to be 2 hours.

Restrictions on traffic will be enforced until normal traffic flow can be maintained following the Event. Where appropriate during the period of the closure, temporary suspension of existing permanent Traffic Orders may be imposed.

Alternative route is via: B1077 Station Road/Buckenham Road/Attleborough Road, C138 The Green/Hargham Road, C153 Hargham Road. A map and further details are also available at <https://one.network>.
