

FLOOD UPDATE

Following the public meeting held in Attleborough Monday night about flooding, Breckland Council will be delivering extra sandbags to the town.

Breckland also have officers on site with Serco colleagues investigating blocked culverts (structures which carry water past obstacles) and their Building Control team are speaking with developers on Norwich Road.
