- Min 012.21** Locations for cycle racks and picnic benches at Gaymers to be confirmed – cycle racks to be confirmed and Clerk looking at picnic benches this week with Senior Groundsman.
- Min 035.22** 4 New Welcome/Gateway to Attleborough Signs Quotations – Clerk had submitted Parish Partnership application with deadline and should hear something during February 2024.
- Min 017.23** Cemetery Hedges Update – feedback received via email which had been responded to confirming hedge would be staying for now and no more adverse comments had been received.
- Min 019.23** Queens Square Cinema Update – Clerk looking at costings and it was suggested to look at this again as a fresh project.

Min 021.23 Provision for Youth Club storage + venue Update – Clerk had visited the Library and enquired whether the site would be suitable, there are rooms available and this was being looked into.

Min 028.23 Benches at Old Post Office Update – Clerk has received no objections from owner and could now look into benches, perhaps just replacing wooden slats to retain character and would discuss with Grounds staff.

Min 029.23 Church Wall Update structural engineers report and other matters – Clerk looking into evidence of any agreement between the Town Council and Dioceses.

Complaint regarding use of Wheel Park after 9pm –

Clerk had requested a meeting with Enforcement Officer, Cllr Tryer and Cllr T Taylor to visit the site for a possible solution.

079.23) Jubilee Wood Update –

Clerk chasing surveys, FRA has been received, Ground Conditions and Topographical surveys have been chased. The Norfolk Wildlife Trust are waiting for surveys before letting us have their report. Clerk will also look at land variation.

081.23) Town Hall Accessibility -

Clerk now employed full time and can spend more time on this. Norfolk Fire Service had visited and assessed the building. Cllr S Taylor requested new curtains be considered. Clerk going to look at changing chairs but still in keeping with the surroundings. Hirers may be asked to set up the room and look into online hall bookings. Investigate a new lift. Cllr T Taylor suggested small workshop to discuss ideas.

A solicitor had been engaged. Cllr T Taylor stated she thought the land would make an accessible allotment site as we didn't have one at the moment. Again, a small work shop where ideas could be discussed would be a good idea.

Clerk told members no S106 money available anymore so will devote time to find alternative funding. A contractor for play equipment was being helpful and could possibly supply details for grant funding.

Cllr T Taylor explained there are funds available currently £73,000 at present Breckland owns the land, it is a very nice large open space and could be used partly as a small community orchard. There are funding opportunities from Breckland applications deadline 5 January 2024. We would have to express an interest and again form a small workshop to discuss ideas.

A place to quietly reflect

Shrubs to be planted, re-planted and retained – lavender, rosemary, winter flowering. Any plants that are fragrant and visually stimulating. Entry for dogs at the site should be permitted. Bins to be relocated towards the entrance gate to allow rubbish to be put in on exit. A small oak tree in the spare area. There is a past report in existence already to refer to. Paths for mobility scooters, wheelchairs. Possible concrete pad at front of site. Chess tables for recreation favoured.

Blackthorn Rd 11.30am

The orchard grant funding is secured. The orchard will make for a more interesting walk. Picnic benches and more bins are needed – but in strategic places. Dog bin is needed at the orchard end. A rewilded area at the orchard end to include hedgehog/insect hotels (behind existing hedgerows also. More bird boxes on the existing trees. (40 trees already on site). Created paths would be beneficial for better access. Trods or tarmac. £73K of S106 for development and maintenance is available. Possible District Member funding of £150,000 is still unclaimed.

St Edmunds Close 12pm

The site is very small and so options are fairly limited. Possible site for two affordable houses. Built by ATC for rent or sale. Possible site for an accessible allotment. Rent or sale of housing would bring in investment for other sites. Acknowledged that the overage agreed of one third would be taken by Breckland.
