



New Kindness Cabin for Attleborough.



The Town Council agreed to support funding for the A Little More Kindness (CIC) to site the new Kindness Cabin in Queens Square Car Park. The much-needed funding includes the hire of the Cabin for two years and installation of an electricity connection and supply. Two disabled spaces have had to be relocated, but to recompense, three have been created at the Town Council's expense in the main car park area. ALMK is a non-profit making organization (a community interest company – CIC). The Kindness Cabin will serve as a local Community Shop for those in need of access to food supplies.
