NORFOLK COUNTY COUNCIL proposes to make a Temporary Traffic Regulation Order (STRO10467) affecting the B1077 Attleborough Road from 250m south of its junction with U33114 Doepham Road for 40m southwards in the PARISH OF GREAT ELLINGHAM to facilitate works to install a new water main.

If necessary, the restriction could run for a maximum period of 18 months from the date of the Order.

Penalty: £1000 maximum fine on conviction and/or endorsement for contravention.

In the event of the start date being delayed the new start date will be displayed on site in advance.
